We have tutors running English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) courses across Somerset from beginners and intermediate to more advanced. We welcome people from all over the world to come and learn English with us and study for English qualifications.



One of our tutors arrived from Ukraine herself in April 2022. Hear her journey...

My name is Maryna and I am from Ukraine. Like millions of Ukrainians, I had to leave my country and look for a peaceful and safe life elsewhere...

I arrived in the UK in April 2022 with my 12-year-old son. We ended up in a picturesque village near Radstock. Our new family surrounded us with care and unbelievable support.

I started looking for a job. When you're in a foreign country, it's crucial to find your feet, to feel important and independent. In Ukraine, I was working as an English and French tutor, so I was over the moon when I managed to find the same job at SS&L.

Now I run English classes for Ukrainian refugees and feel happy when my students thank me after the lesson. Some of them have already gone into employment, whilst others keep on attending my classes and working hard on their English.

Step by step, I've sorted out my new life. I found a flat for rent. I gained Level 5 TEFL Certificate and intend to get into further education and develop myself as a professional. We live our lives, grateful to everyone who gave us a hand when we were in need.



Photography can help you discover the beauty of what's around you. Using a camera allows you to see things in a different light. Once you explore photography, you will realise the benefits of taking a moment to stop and look. Harness your creativity and immerse yourself in a world that will improve your health and wellbeing. The photography workshops and courses that Mark Hall runs are suitable for any abilities, so grab your camera and get snapping!

Understanding Your SLR Camera

This course is ideal for you if you have an entry-level digital SLR camera. Explore the creative possibilities of taking the camera off the programme/auto setting. You will learn to freeze and create movement, have a sharp or blurred background, improve your composition and lots more besides. By the end of the course, you'll have a greater understanding of light, exposure, lenses and shared a learning experience with like-minded friendly people.

Portrait Workshop

Spend a day learning how to take great portraits. We will use natural daylight to explore group and individual photo techniques. Reflectors are supplied to alter light upon your subject and tips on posing will be shared by the tutor. Using different lenses to change perspective and even using flash outside will help create some great images. Bring a friend or family member if you can to use as your model. Images taken are constructively evaluated near the end of the day.

Exploring Photography Further

This is a natural follow-on course from Understanding Your SLR Camera. It's an interesting course further exploring creative camera controls and techniques. Basic studio lighting, photo editing/storage and an insight to photographic history, film cameras and iconic photographers are also thrown into the mix. Practical sessions will explore lighting, still life, long exposures and portraiture.

Osprey Outdoors is an inspirational partner that creates outdoor adult learning opportunities across the Mendip Hills. Their provision includes all aspects of hill walking using ordinance survey map reading skills to navigate the countryside.

The walks are carefully chosen to stretch and challenge you, building on skills and knowledge from each week. This process builds your confidence levels, encouraging you to use your new skills to plan and walk safely across challenging terrains independently.

The project also teaches bush craft skills, such as identifying plants and trees. One of the exercises includes making and lighting a fire without the use of matches or lighters. This builds relationships through teamwork as the group works together to resolve tasks. Many past participants have enjoyed working together so much they created WhatsApp groups.

This project is particularly appreciated by those impacted by mental health issues and they regularly report the huge benefit of exercise and fresh air on their health and wellbeing. Some of the learners are recovering from Long Covid and the negative impact of lockdowns. The project also works closely with a drug and alcohol rehab unit aiding client recovery.

Osprey Outdoors is a great partner that has a big impact on the health and wellbeing of those who take part, whilst teaching skills to get the most from the countryside and the outdoors.

Maths and numeracy - what's the difference?

When you explore the free* maths courses we offer, you might notice some of them talk about numeracy, while others talk about maths.

Confused? Don't worry - here we explain the difference!

With this information up your sleeve, you can be sure to pick the workshop, course or qualification that's best for you.

What is numeracy?

Numeracy is having the confidence and skills to use numbers. Probably without knowing it, you use numeracy on a daily basis. As an example, you might use it at work, when you're giving the right change to a customer, working out how heavy something is, or even filling in spreadsheets. If you're cooking at home, and an extra guest or two turns up, you'll use numeracy to work out how much more you need to make. Setting a weekly budget and understanding how much money to put into your savings are both examples of numeracy in the real world.

So, what is maths?

Maths is a subject that uses numeracy for more complex ideas. It's the study of shapes, patterns and numbers. Maths is a form of science, where students try to prove if something is true or false by using numbers, calculations, equations and fractions. If you have an interest in the other sciences, such as chemistry, biology or physics, you'll need numeracy skills and an understanding of maths to use formulae, measurements and statistics.

Sonia joined one of our very first Maths Confidence sessions held in Yeovil. She enrolled late at night and simply turned up the next day! She had maths anxiety and was worried about walking back into the classroom again after many years of raising her family. 

Worried about paying the loan back?

Student Finance England will write off any outstanding Advanced Learner Loan balance you owe for an Access to HE course, once you complete a higher education course. This means you won't have to repay it. If you don't go on to a higher education course after completing your Level 3 course, you won't have to start repaying the loan until you're earning more than £27,295 per year, regardless of how much you've borrowed. In simple terms, example repayments look like this...
